Update National Protest Disruptions in Belgium

Dear customer,

Please find below the latest update on national protest disruptions in Belgium.

Air Freight

Serious impact is expected. Brussels Airport has decided to cancel all outbound passenger flights today. As a result, cargo operations may face schedule disruptions or cancellations. Inbound cargo flights may also experience delays or be diverted to alternative airports.

Sea Freight

On Wednesday, 11 March 2026, the Antwerp Court of First Instance issued emergency measures to prevent a blockade of the Port of Antwerp. The case, brought by Port of Antwerp-Bruges, Alfaport, and VeGHO, responded to ongoing union actions that had severely disrupted the nautical chain since Monday. Shipping operations have resumed under guidance. Delays are still expected, but the situation is set to improve.

Road Transport

Although detailed information on the impact on road freight remains limited, traffic congestion and indirect delays are likely.

Our teams will continue to monitor the situation closely and work to minimize any operational impact on your shipments.
