250 students who took part in the program took the survey. Half Jews and half Arabs from 10 junior high schools.

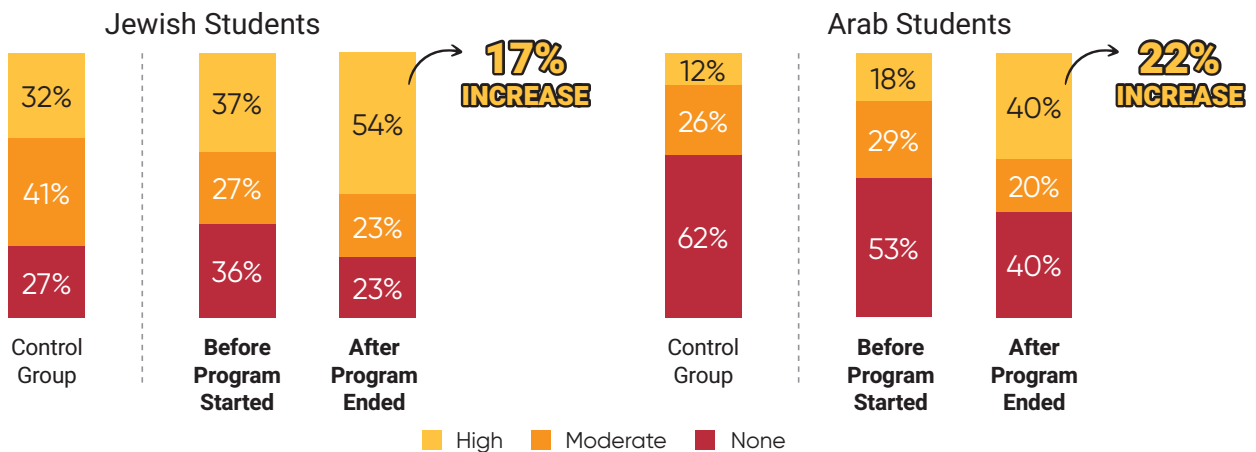
150

150 students from the same schools, who didn't take part in the program - took the survey as a control group

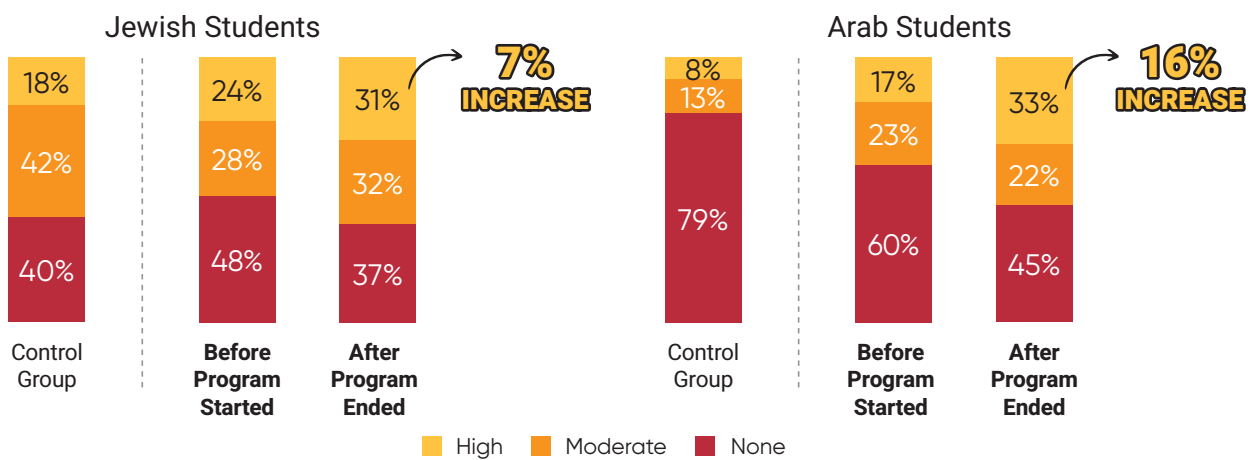

20% Less Fear

Jewish program alumni reported 20% less fear towards the Arab society at the end of the program, compared with their peer students who didn't participate in the program

18% Less Anger

Arab program alumni reported 18% less anger towards the Jewish society at the end of the program, compared with their peer students who didn't participate in the program

Trust, Collaboration & Willingness for Future Encounters

17%
More Willingness

Jewish program alumni reported 17% more willingness for a multi-cultural encounter, compared with their peers who didn't participate in the program

More Continuation

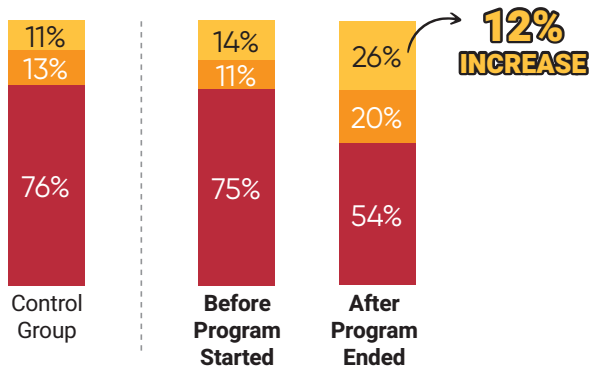
64% of program alumni - Jews and Arabs - reported they are interested in continuing the program next year

More Collaboration

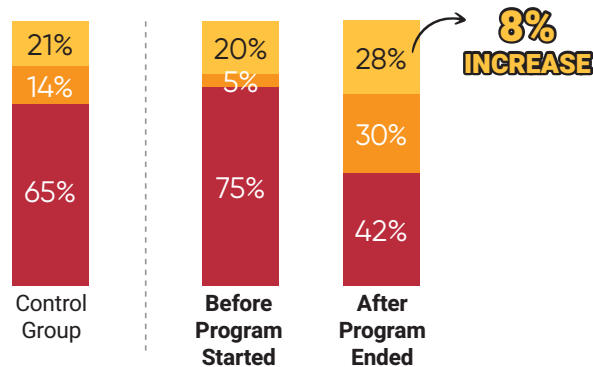
Arab program alumni reported 29% more trust in multi-cultural collaboration, compared with their peers who didn't participate in the program

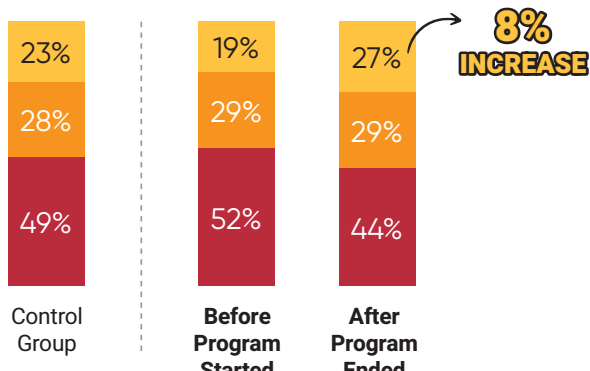

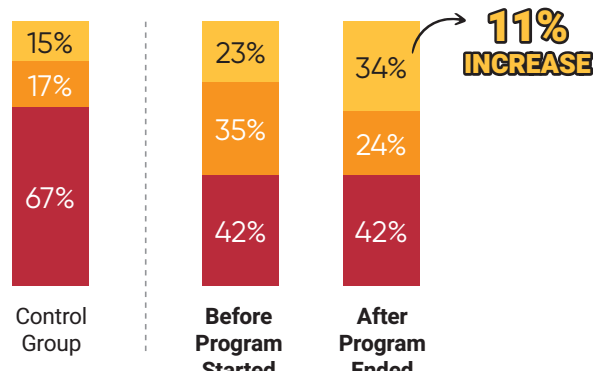
